



<b>CST</b>	<b>Saint</b>	<b>How</b>
Dignity of the Human Person	St. Maximilian Kolbe 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· A Polish Franciscan friar</li> <li>· Founded monasteries in Japan and India</li> <li>· Provided shelter for refugees, and Jews</li> <li>· A martyr in the German death Camp of Auschwitz during World War II by volunteering to take the place of a man with a family</li> </ul>
Family and Community	The Holy Family 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· The Holy Family (Jesus, his mother, the Blessed Virgin Mary, and his foster father, Saint Joseph) are the ultimate model for Christian families</li> </ul>
Solidarity and the Common Good	St. Therese of Lisieux 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· A patron of mission</li> <li>· Taught that through small, loving actions we can deliver God's love to the world. This teaching is called the 'Little Way'</li> <li>· Each year, we are invited to participate in 'Little Way Week' which is an initiative that encourages people to do seven small actions – one a day for a week – to witness to their faith through service</li> </ul>
Rights and Responsibilities	St. Vincent de Paul 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Spent his life preaching missions to and providing relief to the poor</li> <li>· Established hospitals</li> <li>· Extended his concern and ministry to convicts</li> <li>· Founded the Ladies of Charity, a lay institute of women, to help, as well as a religious institute of priests - the Congregation of Priests of the Mission, commonly referred to now as the Vincentians</li> </ul>
Option for the Poor and Vulnerable	St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Established a religious community, Missionaries of Charity, dedicated to the service of the poorest of the poor</li> <li>· Formed the Co-Workers of Mother Teresa and the Sick and Suffering Co-Workers,</li> <li>· Known for her spirit of prayer, simplicity, sacrifice and her apostolate of humble works of love</li> </ul>
Stewardship of God's Creation.	St. Francis of Assisi 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Patron saint of animals and the environment.</li> <li>· Known for his compassion and for his deep connection to all beings particularly the animal kingdom</li> <li>· He cared for the sick and the poor</li> <li>· He believed all creatures were his brothers and sisters under God</li> </ul>
The Dignity of Work	St. Joseph the Worker 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Patron saint of workers</li> <li>· St. Joseph was a carpenter &amp; is often depicted with either the tools of his trade to signify that he was a worker</li> </ul>
